HUMAN CAPACITY BUILDING: JAMB TRAINS STAFF ON ARCHIVING AND RECORD MANAGEMENT

In a bid to properly preserve its records for future use, the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) has organised an eight-day training session

for selected members of staff on archive creation, operation and management towards upscaling their skills for enhanced record-keeping processes.

The training, which commenced on Monday, 25th March, 2024, comprised both theoretical and practical sessions, and involved participants drawn from different departments of the Board. The programme would be coming to a close by 5th April, 2024.

2024 DE APPLICATION WITH UNIVERSITY DIPLOMAS

The Board has been receiving requests for recognition from some institutions awarding university diplomas in affiliation with some universities.

The Board accepts diplomas and degrees awarded by institutions on the basis of their being quality-assured by

NUC, NBTE or NCCE. Any university diploma not awarded directly by any of such institutions and signed by the Vice Chancellor and/or Registrar of the university, on the authority of the Senate is unacceptable

ACCEPTANCE/REJECTION OF ADMISSIONS OR PROGRAMME CHANGE NOW TO BE THROUGH 55019/66019 OR BIOMETRICS

As part of measures to simplify its processes for candidates, the Board has put necessary mechanisms in place to ensure that henceforth, all admissions offered by institutions can only be accepted or rejected either through the 55019 or 66019 channels or by using the candidate's biometrics at any accredited CBT centre or JAMB Office. Through this

facility, candidates would be able to accept or reject any admission offer (programme change inclusive) with his/her fingerprints.

Therefore, the newly-crafted methods of accepting or rejecting admissions, are aimed at protecting the details of the candidates and upholding the sanctity of the admission process.

2024 DE REGISTRATION FURTHER EXTENDED BY TWO WEEKS

The 2024 Direct Entry registration exercise has been further extended by another two weeks and would now close on Thursday, 25th April, 2024.

You will recall that the 2024 Direct Entry registration, which commenced on Wednesday, 28th February, 2024, was initially slated to close on Thursday, 28th March, 2024, but was extended to

the Director, Finance and Accounts, Mr. Mufutau Bello, urged the participants to focus on the training so that they would be able to acquire necessary skills, stressing that archiving is germane to the overall functionality of any organisation.

Speaking further, Prof. Oloyede said archiving provides factual information about an entity, person or organisation, while emphasizing the role of archiving in service delivery, productivity, research and development.

In her remarks, the Director, Quality Assurance, Mrs. Doom Iyortyom,

expressed appreciation to the Registrar for his interest in staff development while encouraging the participants to bring the training to bear on their schedules, as "To whom much is given, much is expected."

"No doubt the training would equip you with invaluable knowledge and priceless skills. Much confidence has been reposed in you through your nomination to participate in this programme. As such, I admonish you to use this opportunity to enhance your horizons towards reinforcing our commitment to the preservation of credibility and sanctity of the Board's historical records," she said.

Taking the participants through the session, the facilitator, Mr. Olayemi Abraham, a renowned archivist with a track record of achievements in archival management and record keeping, likened record management to the life of a biological organism that was born,

lived and died.

In his words, "Records like human beings, pass through certain phases in life. They are created, used and eventually disposed." He stressed that the disposition stage of a record is that time a decision is taken to either destroy the records or send them to the archives while emphasizing that all archives are records but not all records are archives. He, therefore, urged participants to avail themselves of the opportunity afforded by the training to be record-keepers.

NANCES VISIT: JAMB UNCOVERS 1665 FAKE A'LEVEL RESULTS ...Says Verification is to restore Integrity of Certificates

The Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) has uncovered at least 1,665 fake A'level results during the 2023 Direct Entry registration exercise.

The Board also said the A'level results verification regime was occasioned by the endemic corruption associated with the system and was intended to restore the integrity of this component of admission process.

The Registrar, Prof. Is-haq Oloyede, disclosed these alarming figures on Tuesday, 26th March, 2023, when he received the leadership of the National Association of Nigeria Colleges of Education Students(NANCES)in his office.

According to him, out of this figure, 397 were from Colleges of Education, while 453 were university diplomas and the rest for other A'level certificates. He pointed out that it should be of grave concern if no one respects the certificate one

is holding hence, there is need to safeguard the integrity of A'level certificates that is used to secure admission through measures that would stand the test of time.

The Registrar recalled that in the past, when a candidate applied for DE, the Board would simply ask awarding institutions to do the necessary screening and due diligence. He stated that JAMB was dumbfounded by the startling revelations from the Bayero University, Kano(BUK), whereby out of the 148 Direct Entry applications to the institution, only six of the certificates forwarded for processing were genuine.

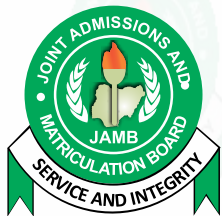
The Registrar added that it was the discovery of this monumental fraud that prompted the meeting of critical stakeholders, who met to chart ways of combating the menace. Part of the measures suggested, he said, was the constitution of an A'level result

verification task force as well as the creation of a common platform for the verification of A'level results and certificates. He said the platform was reliable and user-friendly as it only takes five minutes to verify any given certificate.

Prof. Oloyede also disclosed that to underscore the importance attached to the exercise, the Board has put in place a "No verification, No admission" policy. While listing fifteen institutions that have not sufficiently complied with verification requests from the Board, he stated that the affected institutions with more than 20 unverified candidates, would have to pre-verify candidates applying with their certificates before they could complete their DE registration process.

According to the Registrar, the modification in the ongoing DE registration is that candidates could go ahead and register, while the

LEADERSHIP, MONDAY, MARCH 25, 2024- Civil Servants to Commence Computer-Based Tests For Promotions: In a bid to modernise its operations and ensure transparency, the Federal Civil Service Commission (FCSC) has announced plans to transition to computer-based tests for conducting promotional examinations for its staff.

The move was disclosed by the Chairman of the commission, Prof Tunji Olaopa, during the inaugural monthly seminar series held in Abuja. According to the Chairman, "The commission is transiting through the upcoming 2024 promotion exercise from analogue-rooted practices to computer-based tests and the modernisation and digitisation of its core operations.

"As part of the reform, the FCSC will introduce an online recruitment portal accessible to all Nigerians, allowing eligible candidates to pre-fill recruitment forms and update them ahead of recruitment advertisements."

"To facilitate this transition, the FCSC will enter into an outsourcing contract with the National Open University of Nigeria and the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) as technical partners. This collaboration aims to leverage their infrastructure, networks, and experience for online accreditation, computer-based testing, and promotion interviews, starting with directorate-level officers," he stated."

PREMIUM TIMES, MONDAY, MARCH 25, 2024- Group Partners TETFund, Nigerian Universities to Establish

Research Funding Body: The African Technology Policy Network (ATPN) has announced a collaboration with the **Tertiary Education Trust Fund (TETFund)** and some Nigerian universities to establish a research and innovation funding body in Nigeria.

The Executive Director of the ATPN, Nicholas Ozor, said the establishment of a research and innovation funding organisation would enable Nigerian tertiary institutions to attract innovation funding from international donors.

He said the collaboration is with the African University of Science, Technology and Innovation, the University of Nigeria, and TETFund.

Mr Ozor, who spoke during a workshop at the TETFund headquarters recently, noted that other African countries with functioning research agencies have been able to receive funding from organisations such as Royal Crown Canada, International Development Research Centre (IDRC), German Foundation, Foreign Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO) and British Council, among others.

"Nigeria currently has issues because they do not have a well-recognised national research and innovation funding agency which is part of why we are here to work with appropriate agencies and stakeholders within the science and technology ecosystem to see how we can establish a functional research and innovation funding agency in Nigeria," he said. NATION, MONDAY, MARCH 25, 2024- FG to Carry Out Census of Schools: The Federal Government has said it would carry out a census of all schools in the country.

The government said the data from the census would assist in tackling the challenges facing the sector.

The **Minister of Education, Prof. Tahir Mamman**, stated this recently at a two-day capacity-building workshop for desk officers in the ministry, its departments, and agencies.

Prof. Mamman said the school data would help the ministry to advise the state governments to move to do the right thing.

PUNCH, TUESDAY, MARCH 26, 2024- Nigeria's 149 Private Varsities Undersubscribed-NUC: The National Universities Commission, (NUC) said less than 10 per cent of the two million students in the Nigerian universities are enrolled in private universities.

According to the Commission, there are 149 private varsities in the country.

The acting Executive Secretary, NUC, Chris Maiyaki, made this known at the British Council Workshop on Enhancing Curriculum and Pedagogical Approaches in Nigerian Universities at the Continental Hotel on Monday. He said, "There are over two million students in Nigerian universities and only 10 per cent of the two million are in private universities. The 149 private universities are undersubscribed."

NEWS AGENCY OF NIGERIA, TUESDAY, MARCH 26, 2024- NUT Seeks Establishment of Federal Teaching Service Commission for Effective Delivery: The Nigeria Union of Teachers (NUT) has called for the establishment of a Federal Teaching Service Commission for effective service delivery among unity schools.

The National President of NUT, Comrade Audu Amba, made the call at the 1st Quadrennial Federal Wing Conference of delegates, recently in Abuja.

According to Amba, if the commission is established, it will regulate activities of the unity schools and also reduce burden on the Ministry of Education.

Similarly, the Registrar/Chief Executive, Teachers' Registration Council of Nigeria (TRCN), Prof. Josiah Ajiboye said that there were 112 unity schools across the country with more than 10, 000 teachers, hence the need to have a regulatory body.

LEADERSHIP, WEDNESDAY, MARCH 27, 2024- British Council, NUC Partner on Varsities' Curriculum Design: British Council has partnered with the National Universities Commission (NUC), to design curricula for tertiary institutions.

The Director of Programmes at the British Council, Chikodi Onyemerela said the partnership was essential to align with global trends.

At a workshop titled: "Enhancing Curriculum and Pedagogical Approaches in Nigerian Universities"

in Abuja, he highlighted the importance of transitioning from conventional teaching and learning methods to digital literacy in problem-solving.

NUC has since introduced the Core Curriculum and Minimum Academic Standards (CCMAS), which emphasises the cultivation of critical thinking, digital literacy, problem-solving, and entrepreneurial skills among graduates.

LEADERSHIP, THURSDAY, MARCH 28, 2024- Northern States' Enrolment in Unity Schools Drops: Minister of Education, Professor Tahir Mamman, has expressed concern over low enrollment of students into Federal Unity Colleges among the northern states of the country, emphasizing the need to fill in the gap and utilise their quota in 2024.

Prof. Mamman stated this recently when he visited Kano State Ministry of Education on an Advocacy and Sensitisation Visit aimed at boosting enrollment for the National Common Entrance Examination (NCEE) and Gifted Examination into Federal Unity Colleges.

The Minister who was represented by the Deputy Director and Head Junior Secondary Education, Mrs. Edith Osanyinpejun, revealed that statistics made available to the ministry by the National Examination Council (NECO) indicated that most states in the North had low enrollment in the National Common Entrance Examination and Gifted Examination.

LEADERSHIP, THURSDAY, MARCH 28, 2024- National Library Expands Partnership With Bulgaria: **Commissions a Bulgarian Corner:** The National Library of Nigeria (NLN), has commissioned the Bulgarian Corner at the library's branch in Gark i , A r e a 2 . The corner, holding physical and digitized books is a furtherance on the partnership formed between the apex library and Bulgaria a year ago.

Speaking at the commissioning of

the Bulgarian Corner, The CEO and National Librarian, Prof Chinwe Anunobi said she and her Bulgarian counterpart signed a Memorandum of Understanding for the digitization, preservation of the apex library's repository and manuscripts, in addition to the ensuring the exchange of information, human and material resources between both countries.

This corner will serve as a hub of that relationship. It is open to all Nigerians, and non-Nigerians who seek information from and about Bulgaria. As time progresses, we may create a virtual Bulgarian Corner on our website for those who cannot visit the physical corner."

LEADERSHIP, THURSDAY, MARCH 28, 2024- FG Seeks Collaboration With Swedish Government on Digital Education: The Minister of Education, Prof. Tahir Mamman, has sought collaboration with the Swedish Government on the use of technology to improve education in the country, especially in early child education.

The Minister made the request when the Swedish Ambassador to Nigeria, Annika Hahn-Englund, paid him a courtesy visit in Abuja.

Mamman said that there were many Swedish ICT-based companies in Nigeria and would want their expertise utilised in the education sector.

"Right from primary school, we want our children to be exposed to technology and skills so that they can grow with it and also develop critical thinking capabilities for future skills.

"So, we will be leveraging your expertise and experience in our plans to integrate technology and skills into our schools curriculum," he said.

I, therefore, want to advise parents and guardians to report any case of collection of illegal fees to the Board."

DAILY TRUST, FRIDAY, MARCH 29, 2024- FG Threatens to Sanction Tertiary Institutions Over 'Illegal Recruitment': The Federal Government has threatened to sanction tertiary institutions violating the application of federal character principle in staff recruitment, insisting that such is mandatory.

The Director, Public Affairs and Communication of the Federal Character Commission (FCC), Dr. Chuks Okoli, gave this warning in a statement released recently.

He noted that the Commission has observed with dismay that some federal tertiary institutions now embark on staff recruitment exercise without a recourse to the FCC saddled with the responsibility of ensuring equity, fairness and justice in consonance with Section 14 (B) of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

Therefore, all the FCC guidelines must be strictly adhered to by any recruiting federal tertiary institution. For the avoidance of doubt, please refer to the commission's handbook. Any person, MDA or federal tertiary institution, that carries out recruitment without abiding by the FCC's recruitment guidelines and principles shall be committing an offence under Section 14, punishable

under Section 15 of the act," Okoli said.

DAILY TRUST, FRIDAY, MARCH 29, 2024- Principals Warn Against Scrapping of Secondary Education Commission: The All Nigeria Confederation of Principals of Secondary Schools (ANCOPSS) has warned against scrapping the National Senior Secondary Education Commission (NSSEC) as recommended by the Oronsaye report, pleading with President Bola Tinubu to save the commission.

The National President of the union, Muhammad Musa, said without the Commission, standard and quality would deteriorate in senior secondary schools across the country.

Musa explained that it was at the secondary education level that learners were provided with skills to be useful to self and society, hence that scrapping the commission would destroy the secondary education sector and frustrate the good structure already in place.

It would be recalled that President Tinubu a month ago ordered the full implementation of the Oronsaye report, and as a result, the government announced the merging, subsuming and scrapping of several agencies.

Prof. Oloyede stated these at a thought-provoking lecture held at the University of Nigeria, Nsukka, in a lecture titled: "Institutional Autonomy, Accountability and the Quest for Efficient Governance of Nigerian Universities."

The lecture was in honour of Prof.

Benjamin Chukwuma Ozumba, the 14th former Vice Chancellor of UNN to mark his retirement from the university.

Prof. Oloyede, in his presentation, argued that the two faiths shared fundamental values of peace, compassion, and social justice, hence, his slogan on the occasion: "Examine your Islam! Examine your Christianity!

Nigeria will be better!"

He pointed out that by examining and embracing the teachings of Islam and Christianity, Nigeria could conveniently chart the course for a brighter and more prosperous future for all its citizens.

He called on all university managers to embrace accountability as there is no autonomy without accountability.

This month, the career in focus is Material and Metallurgical Engineering.

Material and Metallurgical Engineering is a field that focuses on the study, development, processing, and application of materials, particularly metals and alloys. It encompasses various aspects related to understanding the properties, structure, and behaviour of materials, as well as designing and improving their performance for specific applications.

Let's break this further down. Imagine you have a big box of Lego bricks. A Material and Metallurgical Engineer is akin to a Lego master builder, but instead of building toys, he works with real materials such as metals, plastics, and other stuff that make up the world around us. So, let's say you have a bunch of different Lego bricks. Some are big, some are small, and are of different colours. Material engineers study all these materials to understand what they are made of, how they are put together, and how

they can be used to make some really cool stuff.

Now, let's talk about metallurgical engineering. Imagine you have a special set of Lego bricks that are made of metal, such as steel or aluminum. Metallurgical engineers focus on these metal 'Lego bricks'. They figure out how to make them stronger, lighter, and more durable. They also learn how to shape them into different things, like cars, buildings, or even spaceships! So, in simple terms, material and metallurgical engineering is all about understanding different materials and figuring out how to use them to build amazing things that make our world better and more awesome! Some key components of material and metallurgical engineering include materials science, metallurgy, materials characterization, materials processing, materials selection and design, failure analysis and prevention, industry applications and research and development.

The career prospects for material and metallurgical engineers are diverse and promising, with opportunities available in various industries and sectors. Here are some areas where knowledge in material and metallurgical engineering can be utilized: Aerospace Industry; Automotive Industry; Energy Sector; Electronics

and Semiconductor Industry; Medical and Healthcare Industry; Construction and Infrastructure; Defense and Aerospace; Research and Development; Manufacturing and Process Industries and many more. It is a five-year course under the faculty of Engineering.

UTME subjects required are: Use of English, Physics, Mathematics and Chemistry. O' level requirements are a credit pass in English Language, Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics and Biology. For special waivers from institutions, check the brochure on www.ibass.jamb.gov.ng.

Institutions offering material and metallurgical engineering include: Air Force Institute of Technology (AFIT), Nigerian Army University, Biu, Ambrose Alli University, FUTMINNA, UNILORIN and others. Check www.ibass.jamb.gov.ng for a comprehensive list of accredited institutions offering the course.

In Nigeria, the regulatory body for material and metallurgical engineers is the Council for the Regulation of Engineering in Nigeria (COREN) while the professional body is the Nigerian Metallurgical Society (NMS). A few outstanding Nigerian material and metallurgical engineers, who have made significant contributions to the field include: Professor Samuel John Ajayi, Professor Fola Esan and Dr. Theresa Akamabebe.

The meeting, which held on Wednesday, 27th March, 2024, at the ITS conference hall, National Headquarters, Abuja, was presided over by the Ag. Director, Information Technology Services (ITS) Department, Mrs. Funmilola B-Usman.

In her opening remarks, Mrs. Usman said the inaugural meeting would focus on the review of the roles and contributions of the CPN as partners in progress. She added that the proposed relationship committee is borne out of the fact that the Board needed to collaborate on how best to derive maximal benefits from its partnership with CPN especially with regard to the participation of CPN in the Board's UTME other than its traditional role of merely monitoring and copying of CCTV footages.

The Ag. Director further disclosed that, the meeting became necessary in view of the complaints lodged by CPN alleging its late involvement in

UTME matters, while the Board, on its part, had been under the impression that CPN members posted on JAMB assignments are not only underutilized but also underperforming. She said that the Board would address the issues raised by CPN going forward.

In his remarks, the Registrar, Prof. Is-haq Oloyede, who was represented by the Director, Test Administration, Mrs. Ville Dachi Pius, who joined the meeting virtually, welcomed the CPN team to the Board.

She said the collaboration was anchored on the Registrar's confidence in the ability of the CPN to contribute meaningfully to the Board's processes hence, the inauguration of the committee. She added that the committee was constituted early enough to ensure the seamlessness of the examination in terms of deployment of relevant technologies and expertise.

Earlier, the Ag. Director had stressed the importance of adhering to the rules of the game as stated in their letter of engagement, which he said would be made available to the committee. He gave the terms of engagement as expressing the expectation of the Board that CPN network experts posted to the field would work as a team with other examinations' officials; collaborating with other

examination officials in terms of technical aspects; and leveraging on CPN expertise to make the conduct of the examinations much better this year.

Mrs. B-Usman also apprised CPN of the fact that many CBT centres are privately-owned and are in the habit of claiming that they have their network experts but the Board believes much more on the expertise of CPN professionals. She reiterated that the Board needs the services of network experts, who could correctly identify and resolve issues that might come up in the course of the examination.

According to the Ag. Director, the Board would need a total of 774 network experts to cover all its accredited centres nationwide. She added that even though warning letters had been sent to those centres, which had issues during the Mock-UTME to repeat their autobot tests before the UTME, issues such as switch malfunctioning, wrong cable connections and IP settings and conflicts might still come up during the examination. CPN experts are, therefore, expected to resolve any issue instead of examination officials placing calls from 774 centres to the Board's situation room. She enjoined CPN to select their best hands for the job.

Meanwhile, the Ag. Director urged the CpN to be mindful of the high level of insecurity in the country, and as such, post its members close to their place of domicile so as to have easy access to their centres.

To familiarise the CPN officials with the task ahead, she disclosed that a training seminar would be organised

in due course to communicate the expectations of the Board. She also stated that a WhatsApp group would be opened for easy communication with CPN nominees. The Assistant Director, ITS, Mrs Rose Emeka, gave some guidelines on what the list of selected CPN officials should contain. These are: names, NIN, e-mail address, account details and phone numbers.

Earlier, the Director, Quality Assurance Department, Mrs. Doom Iyortyom, emphasized the importance of the reporting system stating that her Department is mandated to carry out all the quality assurance processes during and after the Board's examinations.

Consequently, Mrs. Iyortyom said it is mandatory for all examination officials to fill all the necessary forms after each session of the examination, be it attendance, which is compulsory for all the examination officials or malpractice forms (if any) in case of litigation after the examinations. She stressed that all the reports are to be accurate, concise and devoid of ambiguities.

Other members of the ITS staff that contributed were: Mr F. Prisu, and Mr Hillary Amayo.

Prisu, in his contribution, cited a vivid example of his past experience where some CPN staff got to the field and hardly showed any other

concern other than copying CCTV footages. He advised the CPN to educate their members on their new roles for the 2024 UTME. He said he would be expecting a more cordial relationship and teamwork among the exam officials at each centre.

On his part, Mr. Hillary Amaya appealed to the CPN to educate their members on the imperative of attending the pre-examination briefing a day to the exams to enable them know the network architecture and settings in conjunction with the JAMB Technical Officer and the Biometric Verification Officer.

In his response, the leader of the CPN Team and Head, Education Unit, Mr. Amoo Taofeek, expressed appreciation for the initiative and assured the Board that the CPN would not betray the confidence reposed in the body.

The Head, Corporate Communications, Mr. Aderemi Awe, assured the Board of Quality service delivery.

He said with respect to the issue of quality control and assurance, he would guarantee a comprehensive report, which would meet the Board's standard.

The CPN Director, Finance and Accounts, Mr. Aileru Ganiu, assured the Board that their staff would be do the needful in their assigned roles.

Thursday, 11th April, 2024, to accommodate all candidates, who had expressed interest to register for the exercise.

However, against the backdrop of some compelling realities, the Board has further extended the exercise by two weeks from Thursday, 11th April to 25th April, 2024.

This final extension is partly on account of the Easter public holidays, which took off some working days from the exercise and

the upcoming Sallah break, which will also likely affect the slated days for registration as well as the implementation of some novel measures aimed at curbing the series of infractions discovered in the DE component of the admission value chain.

Furthermore, the general public is invited to note the iron-clad determination of the Board to safeguard its systems from threats from whatever quarters, while ensuring that candidates with

genuine credentials are given the opportunity to register for the DE exercise.

However, candidates with questionable credentials are urged in their own interest to stay away from the registration venues as the various measures put in place by the Board are guaranteed to fish out holders of forged or fake certificates for apprehension and prosecution.

RE: ADVISORY ON 2024 DIRECT ENTRY (DE) REGISTRATION, VERIFICATION AND ALIGNMENT OF DATA

This advisory is issued to guide stakeholders on the alignment of data for the 2024 DE registration and verification of candidates' data

1.0 PREAMBLE

The Board has been receiving series of complaints from institutions on candidates with forged or fake A-level certificates. Each institution has the policy of verifying the credentials of admitted candidates to ascertain their authenticity. One of such exercises was carried out by Bayero University, Kano, where the results of 148 admitted students were verified and 142 of them were found to be forged or faked. The Independent Corrupt Practices and other related Offences Commission (ICPC) in conjunction with the Federal Ministry of Education and JAMB subsequently carried out a sting operation at the A-level examination venues across the country. The result of which was extremely embarrassing to the Education sector. The then Chairman of ICPC said that much.

As a result of this, the Board had to, with the approval of the Federal Ministry of Education, act appropriately and establish the Nigeria Integrated Post-Secondary Education Data System (NIPEDS) which has the mandate to verify all A-level certificates used in the DE application before admission is considered.

2024 DE CANDIDATES VERIFICATION FLOW

Find below the flow of candidates' verification by NIPEDS:

Every candidate presents his/her credentials for DE registration at any of the JAMB PRCs/State Offices.

a. Upon receiving the document, it is classified as follows:

- i. For IJMB, JUPEB, NABTEB or Cambridge (post-2018) certificate or awaiting result candidates of IJMB, JUPEB or NABTEB, the candidate data is compared to the databank on NIPEDS for such qualifications. The system checks with the candidate's number as supplied by the respective examination body. The system verifies alignment of name, qualification, subject and grades (where applicable). Once the alignment is confirmed, the candidate continues and completes his/her registration.
- ii. For other qualifications other than "i" above, the credentials of the candidates are transmitted to the respective institution to authenticate/verify the claim.
- iii. If the institution is compliant (credibility of prompt response to verification request in 2023), the candidate is allowed to complete his/her DE registration without waiting for verification of the result from the awarding institution. For the avoidance of doubt, the following 15 institutions are regarded as non-compliant for the on-going 2024 DE registration:

A. Four (4) Universities:

- i. Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria (565 candidates);
- ii. University of Nigeria, Nsukka (125);
- iii. Ekiti State University, Ado-Ekiti (61); and
- iv. Federal University of Technology, Owerri (12).

B. Five (5) Polytechnics/Monotechnics:

- i. Nuhu Bamalli Polytechnic, Zaria (61);
- ii. Akanu Ibiam Federal Polytechnic, Unwana, Afi kpo, Ebonyi State (58);
- iii. College of Health Technology, Calabar (25);
- iv. Best Solution Polytechnic, Akure, Ondo State (24) and;
- v. Federal College of Animal Health and Production Technology, Vom, Plateau State (24);

C. Six (6) Colleges of Education:

- i. Cross River State State College of Education, Akamkpa (91);
- ii. Kashim Ibrahim College of Education, Maiduguri, Borno State (72);
- iii. College of Education, Katsina-Ala, Benue State (47);
- iv. Osun State College of Education, Ila-Orangun, Osun State (27);
- v. Shehu Shagari College of Education, Sokoto (25); and
- vi. College of Education, Waka-Biu, Borno State (20).

2.0 EXPERIENCE/LESSONS FROM 2023 VERIFICATION EXERCISE

The Board had on 23rd February 2023 issued an advisory to guide the registration of candidates seeking admission through Direct Entry (DE) in the 2023/2024 academic session. That was to address the issue of candidates who intended to use forged or fake A-level certificates/qualifications to secure admission.

For effective monitoring, DE registration from 2022/2023 academic session, has been restricted to JAMB-PRCs (offices).

For 2023 registration, of the 44,866 candidates who applied for the DE (or converted from UTME) 1,957 have so far been disclaimed by institutions/examination bodies.

The verification exercise by the Nigeria Post-Secondary Education Data System (NIPEDS) also revealed some discrepancies which could unduly disadvantage students/candidates or provide avenue for their impersonation. The discrepancies are:

Consequently, the Board introduced new measures, through the **THIRD-PARTY A-LEVEL DATA ALIGNMENT PLATFORM (TALDAP)**, to align the data supplied by the candidate with the data supplied by the examination bodies before DE registration.

🌿 The duration of all Non-Full Time Studies must be maintained as approved by the Regulatory Agencies. This is generally not less than one hundred and fifty percent (150%) of the equivalence of Full Time.

🌿 Institutions that desire to place advertisement can do so with the requirement that candidates who sat for the current **UTME** (or **DE** candidates) should change to their institutions as First (1st) Choice rather than requesting the candidates to purchase another application form or apply. This is to prevent the issue of double registration which is a violation of the mandate of JAMB.

🌿 It should be reiterated that no Institution should advertise or sell “application forms” for admissions into the programmes listed above.
